Make something using the AccuQuilt cutter and show it at our June or September show and tells and you will be entered into a draw. All quilts and projects made this year will qualify for a ballot. It doesn't have to be a big quilt. Cut some scraps and make something with them. The library now has the 3” tumbler die and I know some members have been cutting these versatile shapes already. Do you need to put a name on something? The new alphabet and number dies make fun 3” shapes. If you pre-fuse your fabric with fusible, then your shapes are ready for raw edge Appliqué.
